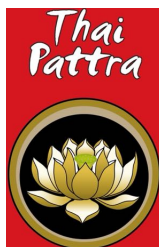

As a result, after the Christmas break, we noticed a shift in the team's attitude, with all players exerting additional effort to improve their performance and play for the team, rather than focusing solely on individual performance.

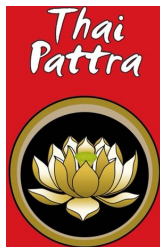

# Vale Tom Adams



Tom's service to the Club spans some 40 of the Club's 50 years. For most of his time at Greystanes Cricket Club he performed the roles of Treasurer, Club Registrar, Gear Steward, fundraiser, purchasing officer and much more. In 1987, the elite title of Life Member was awarded to Tom. But it was the extra commitment that stood him apart. Tom painted Lines on Cricket Pitches. He would drive to all the local grounds on Saturday mornings, open the toilets and lock them again in the afternoon when sporting events had concluded, he knew every player and was always available to help anyone in need.

Throughout this period, Tom made a substantial contribution to both cricket and the administration of sport on the Holroyd area. This includes his service to the Parramatta District Cricket Association of which he is a Life Member, various roles on local park committees in the area covered by the Greystanes Ward. Former Mayors, Councilors, and staff of the former Holroyd City Council all valued Tom's contribution to the Greystanes community.

Together with his wife Shirley, they had lived in Roberta Street for 47 years. Sadly, we lost Tom when he passed away in March 2021 aged 83 to an Asbestos related disease. At this time, Tom was still actively committed to the club. Tom mentored Junior and Senior players, not just in Cricket but in life. During times of personal crisis, everyone could expect Tom's support.

He was a true gentleman, outstanding husband, father, mentor, community leader and friend. His contribution improved the lives of many people in the Greystanes area and beyond. The Club and over 1000 men and boys who have played for Greystanes Cricket Club during Tom's reign all mourn his loss and miss his presence at club activities and the contribution he made to our operations and governance. Tom was also a Life Member of Parramatta District Cricket Association.

The Club's Committee has at its meeting held in August 2022 unanimously resolved to support the naming of the sportsground as the "Tom Adams Oval" in recognition of his contribution to cricket and sport more widely in the Greystanes community. In support of this resolution, the Club has also consulted with Tom's family, other users of Roberta Street Park and the Parramatta District Cricket Association, all of whom are supportive of this proposal.
