Each Junior team is required to have a coach and manager. Your role is to support them by following the points below

- Ensure your child embraces the Code of Behaviour and instils the Spirit of Cricket behaviours into their team:
- You're encouraged to assist during training sessions, don't just stand around and let the coach do everything;
- Communication with your coach and manager is important. If you cannot make training or the game you
 MUST let them know. If a message is sent by the coach or manager, you must reply to it so they know
 you have received it;
- Ensure your child is dressed in white cricket pants, GCC playing shirt, GCC playing hat and predominantly white cricket shoes;
- Do not force an unwilling child to participate in cricket;
- Remember, children are involved in cricket for their enjoyment, not yours;
- Encourage your child to play by the rules;
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing;
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game;
- Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skilful play by all participants;
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities;
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise;
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate;
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Do not leave your child unsupervised i.e. do not drop your child off and expect others to take
 responsibility for minding them unless arranged with other parents. If this happens it may result in your
 child not playing
- You are always encouraged to assist the volunteer coach in game day activities e.g. scoring, arriving early to set the field, umpiring, preparing your child to bat, tidying up at completion
- · Please arrive at training and games at the time the coach asks
