By the Christmas break we had won 3 of our 7 games including a close two run victory against Kellyville and a dominate victory over Seven Hills. Unfortunately, after Christmas, as we all know not much cricket was played, only completing one game and not getting the chance to finish two others out of 7 games.

I think our strength as a team was our bowling, although we did not get maybe as many wickets as this might suggest our players consistently beat with bat with some of the boys getting the ball to genuinely swing, Axel and Josh H being my outswingers beating the bat and unfortunately off stump regularly and Kunal, Lucas and Josh A with some hooping in swingers getting through the defences and missing leg stump as well.

It would have been good to have had a full season to gauge their improvements. Some personal highlights with the bat included Dylan (21), Vihaan (19) and Josh A (18) making their highest season scores all in the same game. All players had at least one game without being dismissed with Axel being a stand out in this area only being dismissed 5 times (3 in one game), Josh A and Josh H only dismissed 7 times, Josh H being the only player not to be dismissed multiple times in a single game.

The boys did pretty well in the field with everyone trying their best. Axel took 4 catches, Lucas, Kunal and Josh A took 3 catches each. Lucas got 7 run outs, Josh H got 5, Axel and Josh A getting 3 each.

I hope all the boys had an enjoyable season and that I was able to give them some useful tips as they move into the under 12's next year where things get a bit more competitive. Thanks to Keti for managing and scoring, even though I know you hate it, Simon for his efforts as co-coach and doing square leg on game day, Jamie for scoring and helping out at training and game day along with Steve and all the other parents for coming and supporting team each week.
