In the field, many hard catching chances were taken and he always demonstrated a commitment to fielding well and communicating with others. As a batsman, Thomas demonstrated an ability to learn the fundamentals of batting and transfer his knowledge to quality time in the middle.

Samuel Broschofsky- As a bowler, Samuel would consistently break established opposition batting partnerships and would dismiss many top line batsman throughout the season. In the field, he always gave 100% and was always thinking and staying focused, a great quality to have in a young cricketer. As a batsman, Sam could hold his own with the rest of the competition and was involved with several top quality partnerships.

As a fielder, his skills rapidly developed in the discipline of wicket- keeping and in my opinion, was the best keeper in the Parramatta District Cricket Under 11 Competition. Liam Ford- As a bowler, Liam demonstrated an understanding of the qualities of a top line spinner and was rewarded with several wickets throughout the year. In the field, many tough catching chances were taken, as he applied pressure to the opposition.
