Please don't get caught up in statistics and averages and the like because focusing on them means that you are focusing on yourself. Instead if you catch that ball in the outfield that someone else had bowled, that is for the betterment of the whole team and therefore we celebrate it as a team.

We would like to extend a warm thankyou to the handful of parents who assisted by scoring, setting up the field and staying around each week to watch and support the kids.

To the parents that did the drop off and run at training and Saturday mornings, I would like to encourage you to get more involved next year. Everyone is busy and some may not have the knowledge of the game to score or umpire, but everyone is able to pat their son on the back when he comes off the field and encourage him and others. It means so much to the boys to have their parents there taking an interest in what they do.

Special mention must be made of Bradley who led from the front, taking the greatest number of wickets for the team while also managing to score a century during the season.

Ashley, out of all the boys, was the best in exhibiting strong Teamsmanship throughout the year. He was the player who always ran drinks out to the batters in the middle, turned up on time to training and games each week and always encouraged his teammates. There is no app that will record these actions, but every coach would love all their players to have the same enthusiasm and commitment that Ashley demonstrated during the season. Ashley's positive attitude also flowed onto the field with him doing exactly what we have been trying to teach all the bowlers. It doesn't matter about how fast you can ball or how much you can spin, it's the line and length that's important at this level. Ashley had it spot on almost every time, with some outstanding figures to match.


