Over the last summer, I have had the pleasure to co-coach the Greystanes under 12/2's cricket team with John Olsen. A season that started out with only 8 players was meant to be nothing more than a learning experience for the kid's. However, with the addition of some new recruits to the club and the continued improvement of our current players, we continually had to revise up our expectations.

After being rolled for 32 (including 20 extras) in the first innings of round 3, things could only improve, and they did. In the second innings we declared at /151 and the kids started to get some self-belief. Round 4 saw our first win based on a fantastic batting display of 7/280 which included 79 by Kieran Kumar and 78 from Connor Olsen. This win was backed up by a great win in round 5 though this time based on a dominant bowling display. We only scored 92 but managed to roll Wentworthville for 84 with a great team bowling performance highlighted by Kyle Laybutt with 45 for 11 off 7 overs. From here on the kids learnt to have faith in both their batting and bowling abilities and we only lost once again during the home and away season to finish the season in 3rd place.

Everyone continued to train hard (whilst still having some fun) and we managed to win the semi-final with great all-round performance in restricting Baulkham Hills to 8/62 then chasing them down with 4/63 with more than an over to spare. That led us to the big one.

After a bit of a shaky start to our batting (3/5 then 4/18) a few partnerships developed and so did the confidence. A major turning point in the game was a 48 run 8th wicket partnership between Matt Rothwell (30n.o. and umpires' man of the match) and Zach Olsen (18, not bad for an 8 year old) and we finished with a total of 116. On day 2 our bowlers started very accurately and at drinks Winston Hills were 3 for 56. After the break the kids continued to believe in themselves and in the end they rolled them for 64 with Kiran taking 3 for 4 and Kyle 3 for 11. It was an amazing day and something that the kids worked hard all year to achieve.

We had some stand out players this year with Connor Olsen taking an amazing 19 wickets for just 66 runs giving him the outstanding average of 3.47 and an economy rate of 0.83 runs per over. Nitin Moopnar also took 19 wickets including a 5 for 5 and when you add to this scoring over 200 runs with the bat, had an outstanding debut season. These two were also helped out by Kyle (13), Nikhil Eraman (11) and Kiran (11) taking regular wickets. On the batting side Kiran Kumar scored 211 runs and was ably supported by Nitin, Connor and Matt Rothwell with all scoring over 100 runs for the year.

This season was also very enjoyable to see the improvement in all the kids, Sooriya Rajeswaren took on a leadership role within the team and his general enthusiasm was fantastic. Dan Wilson improved greatly as a keeper as the year went on and Andrew Marner, Venkat Aluru, John Curtis, Liam Formosa and Aida Marner all continued to improve throughout the year.

To finish, I just want to say it was an honour to coach this wonderful group of kids who always showed outstanding sportsmanship and were a pleasure to be around. You all deserved your success.
