MEMBERSHIP FEES

INITIAL JOINING FEE

Joining Fee to Greystanes Cricket Club \$0.00 (There is no initial joining fee.)

ANNUAL SENIOR MEMBERSHIP FEE

Full Time Senior Player	\$270 plus \$36.50 Annual National Registration fee
Casual Player (Max 3 games)	\$120 plus \$36.50 Annual National Registration fee
Senior Player Still in High School (U18)	\$220 plus \$17.45 Annual National Registration fee
Senior Player Still in High School (O18)	\$220 plus \$36.50 Annual National Registration fee
Early Bird (expires 20/7/25)	\$20 is saved for all Junior and Senior registrations
Cricket Australia Processing fee	1.49% of entire registration cost

- Umpire fees
- Playing shirt
- Hat
- Individual Voting rights at any Club meeting

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ANNUAL JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP FEE

Junior registration fee	\$220 plus \$17.45 Annual National Registration fee.
Early Bird (expires 20/7/25)	\$20 is saved for all Junior and Senior registrations
Cricket Australia Processing fee	1.49% of entire registration cost

- Ordinary membership to One Parent or Guardian and individual voting rights at any Club meeting.

REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

Any junior or senior player desirous of joining the Greystanes cricket Club must comply with the following:

- 1) Complete the required registration form on PLAYHQ. All registrations will be made online.
- 2) Membership and registration fees payment is mandatory during the PLAYHQ registration process i.e., a registration will not be successful unless payment is made.
- 3) Junior registration may need to be confirmed by either a birth or baptismal certificate.
- 4) Junior Coaches will have their own registration fees waived. For example, A senior player who coaches a junior team will not pay registration fees for the season that they are coaching and playing.
- 5) A single registration fee is waived for sponsors that provide in-kind or monetary value of \$3,000 or over in the twelve months of their sponsorship.
- 6) Playing Club President does not pay Registration fees.

GENERAL

- Coaches and managers for junior teams shall be appointed by the management committee
- Junior team captains and vice captains shall be selected by the team Manager and Coach.
- Senior team captains and vice captains shall be selected at the general meeting following the Annual General Meeting

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TROPHIES

The club shall endeavour to award trophies to any team or player for outstanding performance during the season. Such awards being decided upon by the management committee.

- Junior Awards Stage 2 – To qualify for the ‘Average’ or ‘Aggregate’ award, 100 runs must be scored. To qualify for the bowling ‘Average’ or ‘Total Wickets’ award, 12 wickets must be taken.
- Junior Awards Stage 3 – To qualify for the ‘Average’ or ‘Aggregate’ award, 150 runs must be scored. To qualify for the bowling ‘Average’ or ‘Total Wickets’ award, 15 wickets must be taken.
